

3. The personnel allowance for this unit will be cancelled. All billets will be reprogrammed within the Radionavigation Aids (RA) Program.
4. Commandant (G-EEE) will provide disposition instructions for any excess electronics equipment. Dispose of any other property which becomes excess as a result of this action in accordance with the Comptroller Manual (CG-264), the Real Property Manual (CG-262), and the Logistics and Property Handbook (CG-469-6).
5. Destroy classified material locally in accordance with the Security Manual (CG-444).

1. You are hereby authorized to disestablish USCG Loran-C Monitor Station Eglin, FL, during the First Quarter of Fiscal Year 1980 in consonance with termination of the existing U.S. East Coast Loran-C Chain, rate 9930. As outlined in reference (a), disestablishment and complete removal of all Loran-C monitor functions from LORMONSTA Eglin will be accomplished in two phases. The first phase is to unman and operate Eglin as an unmanned Loran-C monitor site. The second phase is to cease all Loran-C monitoring functions, remove the equipment and completely vacate the Eglin site once a suitable replacement monitor site is established and operating.
2. Unit OPFAC Number 08-40485 and Activity Address Code Z40485 are cancelled upon disestablishment. All references to this unit will be removed from the OPFAC. Direct the Commanding Officer to submit Form CG-4183, Change of Mailing, Freight and Billing Address, at least 30 days prior to disestablishment. Advise Commandant (G-WAN) by message of the effective date of disestablishment.
3. The personnel actions outlined in reference (a) shall be accomplished. The personnel allowance for LORMONSTA will be cancelled. All billets will be reprogrammed within the Radionavigation Aids (RA) Program.
4. Commandant (G-EEE) will provide disposition instructions for any excess electronics equipment. Dispose of any other property which becomes excess as a result of this action in accordance with the Comptroller Manual (CG-264), the Real Property Manual (CG-262), and the Logistics and Property Handbook (CG-469-6).
5. Destroy classified material locally in accordance with the Security Manual (CG-444).
6. This action will be accomplished with funds programmed by you for the scheduled closure. OG-30 funds from LORMONSTA Eglin will be retained for support of unmanned sites within your district.
