My dear Mr. Wozley:

The Coast Guard has been assigned responsibility for implementation of the LORAN-C system, an electronic aid to navigation, in support of classified Defense programs. Specified coverage in the Central North Pacific area requires stations in the vicinity of the Trinity Islands and Attu, Alaska.

A preliminary investigation group determined that suitable sites were located at: Whirlpool Point, Sitkinak Island, Trinity Islands; and Barabara Point, Massacre Bay, Attu Island, Aleutian Islands. Detailed site surveys are scheduled for these areas during July and August 1959.

I request that the above property be reserved for use by the Coast Guard for aids to navigation facilities. Specific information regarding boundaries of the required land will not be available until completion and approval of the detailed site surveys.
