SUBJECT: LORAN-C Blink procedures

1. Mr. John MORRISON of Sperry-Rand Corporation called on Friday, 11 June 1965 at 1600 to inquire about changed Loran-C Blink procedures. He had learned about the proposed change in the Memorandum to Awaiting of 7 May 1965. He desired to have official notification of what changes would be made and when they would be made. He and his company needs this information in order to submit a proposal to the Navy for a new Loran-C receiver/indicator. The company is encountering some difficulty in designing the Blink Detection Circuit of the receiver.
