1. BRIGADIER JAN GAARE, ASSISTANT CHIEF OF STAFF AT
MINISTRY OF DEFENSE FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS
AND ACTION OFFICER FOR CLARINET PILGRIM,
HAS PROPOSED MEETING BETWEEN RESPONSIBLE U.S. GOVERNMENT
OFFICIALS AND NORWEGIAN AUTHORITIES. PURPOSE OF MEETING

3. NORWEGIANS ARE PREPARED TO TRAVEL LONDON FOR MEETING (THEIR RATIONAL IS BOTH US COAST GUARD EUROPE AND CINCUSNAVEUR BASED IN LONDON) OR TO RECEIVE US OFFICIALS IN OSLO AT MUTUALLY AGREED TIME. WHATEVER ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEETING WITH NORWEGIANS ON CLARINET PILGRIM,WE BELIEVE US ANSWERS TO NORWEGIAN QUESTIONS WILL HAVE DIRECT BEARING ON NORWEGIAN GOVERNMENT DECISION. RANK,NEGOTIATING AUTHORITY AND MAKEUP OF US DELEGATION SHOULD REFLECT THIS FACT.

1. WHAT IS RATE OF INFORMATION THE SYSTEM CAN CARRY(NUMBER OF CHANNELS,BITS/CHARACTERS PER SECOND)? WOULD AN INCREASE OF PRESENTLY PLANNED INFORMATION CAPACITY RESULT IN NAVIGATIONAL DEGRADATION? IF SO, WHAT IS CONSIDERED PRACTICAL LIMIT?

2. IF SYSTEM CAN CARRY MORE THAN ONE CHANNEL,CAN CHANNELS BE OPERATED INDEPENDENTLY BY DIFFERENT USERS? COULD,FOR INSTANCE, NORWAY AND US INDEPENDENTLY UTILIZE DIFFERENT STATIONS IN SAME CHAIN? CAN DOUBLE RATED STATIONS BE KEYED INDEPENDENTLY OF EACH OTHER?

3. CAN EACH SEPARATE LORAN-C STATION BE OPERATED AS AN INDEPENDENT COMMUNICATIONS TRANSMITTER? IS THERE IN THIS RESPECT ANY DIFFERENCE BETWEEN MASTER AND SLAVE?

4. CAN THE SYSTEM OFFER ANY CAPACITY AS AN INTERSTATION COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM FOR LORAN-C CHAIN?

5. WOULD INTRODUCTION OF CLARINET PILGRIM HAVE CONFIDENTIAL

8. WHAT TYPE OF TRAFFIC---IN GENERAL TERMS--WOULD BE PASSED OVER THE SYSTEM?

9. WHAT SECURITY CLASSIFICATION WILL BE PLACED ON CLARINET PILGRIM:

A. IN IMPLEMENTATION PHASE?

B. IN OPERATIONAL PHASE?

10. COMMANDER NORTH NORWAY (COMMON) AS A PRINCIPLE SUBORDINATE COMMANDER TO CINCNORTH IN WAR, WILL EXERCISE RADIO TRANSMISSION CONTROL OF LORAN-C TRANSMITTERS, IN HIS AREA OF COMMAND IN ACCORDANCE WITH MC-136(PARA 8).
