Subj: Use of Naval Station Quarters and Messing Facilities;  
request for

1. This command is the separation point for Philippine nationals from the U. S. Coast Guard. In some cases personnel arrive without the necessary records to enable a timely separation. As no government quarters or messing facilities are available in the Manila area, these delays in separation become inordinately expensive to the government in payment of per diem.

2. It is requested that the Naval Station, Subic Bay, provide to this command, on a not to interfere basis, subsistence and quarters to Coast Guardsmen awaiting separation, on a non-reimbursable basis. The administrative processing of these separations would continue to be completed by this command.

3. The number of Coast Guardsmen arriving for separation is not expected to exceed ten a year.
