1. On or about 1 May 1973 you are hereby authorized to execute the following changes set forth in reference (a).

- a. Disestablish U. S. Coast Guard Section, Philippines.
- b. Establish Senior Coast Guard Officer, Philippines.
- c. Establish Loran-A Technical Assistance Detail, Manila.
- d. Designate Commanding Officer, Merchant Marine Detail, Manila as Senior Coast Guard Officer, Philippines.

Notify the Commandant (GWAN) by message when the above changes are completed.

2. Changes to OPFAC (CG-244) required by these actions, together with OPFAC numbers, are:



3. The Commanding Officer, Merchant Marine Detail, Manila will also be the Senior Coast Guard Officer, Philippines (SCGOP). The present Deputy Section Commander shall be designated Commanding Officer of the Technical Assistance Detail, to serve as SCGOP (ACTING) in the absence of the officer specifically assigned as such. The Commander billet presently authorized for the Section Commander shall be deleted and reassigned as Coast Guard liaison officer with the Environmental Protection Agency. The remainder of the billets now assigned to Philippines Section Officer shall be retained for the Technical Assistance Detail.
4. Funds to accomplish these changes are available and will be the subject of separate correspondence.
5. Changes to the standard Distribution List are automatic. Submit a Change of Mailing, Freight and Billing Address, form CG-4183 provided in the Standard Distribution List, CG-131, at least 30 days in advance of these changes.
6. Initial distribution of required directives and publications will be forwarded automatically by Commandant (GCAS) upon receipt of form CG-4183.
