Once the Japanese took over operations of the NWPAC Loran Chain they didn't need coverage for Guam area so they only used the Japan stations. They closed Iwo and relocated the master station to O'Shima where the old Loran-A station was many years ago. Also the initial monitor station for the northern triad was on O'Shima.
