**MEMORANDUM:**

**Subj: Disposal of Barracks Building at Loran Transmitting Station, Hobe Sound, Florida**

**Ref: (a) Headquarters Administration Order No. 8-52, 19 March 1952**

1. The Commander, 7th Coast Guard District, transmits Board of Survey No. 07-350370-4-53, covering disposal of barracks building at Loran Station, Hobe Sound, Florida.
2. The Board finds that the structure is a wood frame building, 104'x35'. Overall condition of building is very good with no evidence of termite damage, few pieces of siding rotten and iron nails weeping rust through white paint; front porch screen fastenings require renewal; 2" x 10" pine floor joists and framing, and 2" x 8" pine ceiling joists and rafters in good condition and salvagable.
3. The building is located on land presently held on lease which expires on 30 June, 1953. The owners do not desire to renew lease, hence the building must be disposed of by 30 June, 1953.
4. The Board, with the approval of the Commander, 7th Coast Guard District, recommends that the building be offered for sale intact, less furnishings, by competitive bid.
5. This office concurs with the recommendation of the Board.
6. In accordance with the above reference, the following offices are requested to indicate retention or disposal.
