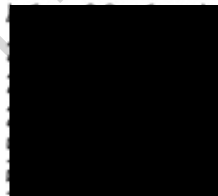

1. The closure process for Sardinia, outlined in reference (a), has begun. 
