1. On 2 June 1962 Nantucket LTS will commence operation as Slave Y for the East Coast LORAN-C Chain. Calibration will proceed immediately.
2. On or about 1 August 1962, upon completion of calibration of the new East Coast Chain and upon deactivation of the unit by station personnel, Martha's Vineyard LORAN-C Station should be disestablished.
3. It is requested that you initiate action for the disestablishment of subject station.
