Station "NORTH SLAVE" is a 6 inches by 6 inches concrete monument with a cross cut in the top. Monument projects 3 inches above ground. An eroded Japanese figure is cut on the north side of the monument.

Station "NORTH SLAVE" is located on southwest corner of Hokkaido, Japan, 1½ miles west of Matsumae, ¼ mile south of US Air Force Radar Station, 200 meters southwest of gravel road, and 135 meters west of prominent rock outcrop which has been adorned with Japanese shrines, dedicated to the drowned fishermen of this area.
