Station "SOUTH SLAVE" is a 6 inches by 6 inches polished granite monument. No marks are cut on monument. Monument is set in concrete and projects 2 feet above ground.

Station "SOUTH SLAVE" is 2½ miles north of Yonago, Honshu, Japan, ¼ mile east of the abandoned Japanese Yonago airfield, the east side of which is marked by a drainage ditch, 250 meters south of water line of Miho Bay, 125 feet northeast of 8-inch pine tree, and 75 feet northwest of 8-inch pine tree.
