1. Reference (a) indicated that the decision concerning provision of family housing at DOOR IV was being held in abeyance. Subsequent recommendations contained in references (b) and (c) fully support the need for a reasonable amount of family housing at this station. Subject to the following comments, therefore, the construction of family housing at DOOR IV is approved in principle.

a. Housing for a maximum of 8 families should be provided. Use of duplex type structures should be adhered to for reasons of economy. Each set of quarters should provide 3 bedrooms.

b. Housing for the remainder of those personnel assigned should provide bachelor-type quarters similar to that approved by reference (d).

2. It is requested that the Engineer-in-Chief in consultation with the Chief, Office of Operations prepare and submit to the Chief of Staff for approval preliminary arrangement drawings for all necessary housing and living spaces.
