Subj: Wardroom mess for Commanding Officer, Loran Transmitting Station,

1. In a recent communication to this office, Lieutenant (j.g.) C. S. Marple, Commanding Officer, Loran Transmitting Station, Hawi, Hawaii, requested permission to use the commanding officer's hut for quarters for himself and his wife, inasmuch as he had found that adequate housing would be almost impossible to obtain in that vicinity.
2. This District approves this suggestion very highly as this would permit the commanding officer to be immediately available in the event of a disaster and for any other official purposes requiring expediency after office hours.
