1. Parting company with CWO3 Brazil at Rome, I continued onto LORSTA Kargaburun, Turkey, from 10 - 16 November 1990.

2. The purpose of the visit was to obtain:

(a) Specific information, as requested by LT J. Sylvester, were perimeter fence lighting and terrorist alarm update.

(b) Current layout data of existing and new structural equipment.

The station at Kargaburun is almost identical to that of Sellia Marina in both facility structures and site arrangement, therefore, familiarization was easy and followed a working format similar to that of the previous week.

3. The data obtained from this visit will be transposed onto existing drawing originals or used to generate new drawings as necessary.

4. This was my first experience of staying on the station itself and provided me with the opportunity of a game of football with the crew and a game of soccer with the Turkish soldiers.

5. Morale at Kargaburun was great and everybody was very helpful. The highlight of the trip being a visit to the bazaar in Istanbul, followed by a Tex-Mex speciality by Mr. Tex-Mex himself, LTJG Rey Quiroz!
