SUBJECT: **Daily Logs from the (Nipisat Loran Station) in Greenland**

Attached for transmittal to the Commander, First Coast Guard District, Massachusetts, are the daily logs for November and other technical data from the Nipisat loran station, Disco Island in Greenland.

By error the logs for October were delivered by the Ministry for Greenland to the office of the Air Attache, which transmitted these direct to Washington through its channels. The Air Attache's records indicate that these logs were received in Washington on December 16.

The Embassy has been unable to ascertain the whereabouts of the September logs which the Department states were not attached with the Embassy's covering despatch no. 317 of October 13, 1955. The Ministry for Greenland has indicated that it will attempt to secure duplicates of these logs and if and when these are received by the Embassy they will be transmitted to the Department.
