CITATION:

"For meritorious service from 15 December 1976 to 17 September 1977 while engaged in providing continuous Loran navigational service in the Mediterranean Sea area. Demonstrating exceptional professional ability, personnel of Loran Station Estartit maintained an unprecedented 100-percent availability of their Loran-C signal transmissions throughout the entire period. This achievement was accomplished despite the fact that the Loran-C transmitter was the oldest type in the Coast Guard's inventory and operated in the "unwatched mode" without a live watchstander present in the critical equipment spaces. Additionally, through extra attention to routine tasks, a thorough understanding of equipment operation, and innovative temporary repairs, signal availability was maintained despite several failures of major backup and support equipment. The outstanding skill, diligence and devotion to duty displayed by personnel of Loran Station Estartit reflect great credit upon themselves, their unit and the United States Coast Guard."
