CCGDFOURTEEN OPORDER 05-93

LORAN STATION MARCUS ISLAND - DISESTABLISHMENT AND TURNOVER TO JAPAN

- Ref: (a) COMDT(G-NRN) OFCO 029-93 of 4 June 93
(b) COMDTINST M5060.12, Military Ceremonies Planning Guide for Shore Stations
(c) COMDTINST M2400.1F, Radio Frequency Plan
(d) Memorandum No. 3077 to the Joint Committee, Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA) signed 23 July 1992

TIME ZONE: ZULU plus 09 hours for all operations.

1. SITUATION:

a. In accordance with reference (a), LORAN-C Station (LORSTA) Marcus Island, Japan will disestablish and transfer LORAN-C operations to the Government of Japan on or about 01 October 1993.

b. A commemorative ceremony marking the Northwest Pacific (NWPAC) LORAN-C Chain turnover to the Japanese Maritime Safety Agency (JMSA) will take place at FESEC on 14 September 1993. A disestablishment ceremony will be held on or about 01 October 1993 at LORSTA Marcus Island.

c. This OPORDER pertains to the administrative disestablishment and turnover of station property and equipment to JMSA. LORAN operation as the Whiskey secondary transmitting station for the NWPAC LORAN-C Chain (9970-W) shall continue uninterrupted with operational parameters maintained by JMSA.

e. Enemy Forces: Not applicable.

f. Detachments: Upon completion of disestablishment procedures on or about 01 October 1993, all USCG personnel permanently assigned to the unit will depart for permanent change of station assignment. A small detachment of USCG personnel will remain at FESEC until 30 October 1993 to handle matters related to the closure of all NWPAC LORSTAs.

2. Mission: Prepare LORSTA Marcus Island for turnover to JMSA and provide on-site training to JMSA personnel during the period 01 - 30 September 1993. Perform administrative and accounting duties in preparation for station disestablishment.

3. Execution: In accordance with reference (a), LORSTA Marcus Island prepare the station for turnover to JMSA, conduct on-site training for JMSA personnel, and complete administrative disestablishment procedures no later than 01 October 1993 IAW reference (b)

a. LORSTA Marcus Island with assistance from Commander, Coast Guard Far East Section:

(1) Notify COMDT(G-NRN) by message of the date and time all turnover and disestablishment activities are complete. Provide status report on condition of facility. Remarks should include but are not limited to the following: all general purpose property and electronic equipment have been transferred to JMSA or distributed as directed by this OPORDER. Include status report of items listed in paragraph 3.a.(23) of this OPORDER. Message format and addressee are provided as enclosure (1).

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(2) Provide CG Institute, either by letter or message, a roster of personnel and PCS destination affected by this change.

(3) Diners Club Card holders are reminded to submit a transfer notice with orders attached to CCGD14(aco). DC Coordinators must ensure card holder accounts are Paid-in-full prior to departure.

(4) Return all unused urinalysis supplies to CCGD14(aps).

(5) Inventory, account for by DD-1149 and return all unused ID cards to CCGD14(ap).

(6) Review all outstanding purchase orders, including BPAs and recurring purchase orders, and prepare modifications to cancel any outstanding purchase orders for material/services no longer needed. Ensure receiving reports have been forwarded to FINCEN for all completed purchase orders.

(7) Ensure all obligations are cancelled or modified. Cancel all outstanding ARMS requisitions. Forward all open procurement files and completed procurement files not disposed of under other instructions in this OPORDER to FESEC. Forward LUPS data file, complete with all accounting/document control files to FESEC.

(8) Submit enlisted dining facility closing report. This report should include status of inventory, by item and amount, transferred/disposed of by survey, etc.

(9) Submit final report with survey for remaining inventory of fuel supply fund (85) to CCGD14(af).

(10) If an Imprest Fund is involved, close out fund and return funds to FESEC with final report.

(11) Forward a list of historical artifacts to COMDT(G-CP) no later than 30 days prior to disestablishment. Artifacts are the property of the U. S. Coast Guard and any unauthorized transfer of artifacts is illegal. Artifacts must be shipped directly to the Coast Guard Exhibit Center, 7945 Fernham Lane, Forestville, MD 20747 unless otherwise authorized by COMDT(G-CP-3). Forward copies of transfer documents to CCGD14(af) via FESEC.

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(12) Inventory, package and ship any silver service to Coast Guard Supply Center Baltimore marked for "Project 54A".

(13) Conduct an inventory of all general purpose (GP) and plant property to verify accuracy of current property listings. Provide equipment lists, as required by paragraph 5 of reference (a), separately listing equipment to be turned over to the Government of Japan and equipment to be returned to the Coast Guard. Provide required lists to FESEC for assembly into a combined report. Submit to CCGD14(af) via FESEC Personal Property Accountability (PPA) Report along with Reports of Survey (CG-5269) and signed DD-1348-1 forms for excess property disposed of at DRMO.

(14) Ensure equipment (EEIS) and parts (ERPAL) items with "XB" cognizant are accurately and fully accounted for, including quantity and serial numbers. Provide listing of these items to CCGD14(oan) for consolidation and forwarding to COMDT(G-TEO) via MLCPAC(tes) which accurately reflects the inventory at the time of turnover to JMSA. Include, with the list, the number of line items and dollar value of ERPAL inventory at the time of turnover.

(15) Ensure accuracy of IRM inventory and transfer IRM equipment to USCG Base Honolulu M/F CCGD14(dtis). Forward copies of DD-1149, citing equipment serial numbers, directly to CCGD14(dtis). Standard work stations (SWS) installed as stand-alone communication terminals integrated into the LORAN Timing and Control suite will be left in place for use by JMSA. As such they must be included with the equipment (EEIS) inventory as required by paragraph 3.a.(14) above.

(16) Dispose of any COMSEC material and equipment in accordance with instruction from TISCOM(ops) as per CMS-6. Follow instructions contained in COMDTINST 2600.1 (series) to disestablish COMTAC accounts. Destroy all remaining classified material and forward all certificates of destruction to CCGD14(dtis) in accordance with the CG Security Manual, COMDTINST M5000.11

(17) Transfer government vehicles to JMSA. Provide transfer document/DD-1149, clearly identifying vehicle by make/model and serial number, Part II of the CG-4327 Vehicle Acquisition and Disposition Report completely filled out,

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(17) (contd) including final odometer reading and sign, and the old license/DOT tags to CCGD14(af), Attn: Mr. Erickson.

(18) Dispose of medications and controlled drugs in accordance with the CG Medical Manual, COMDTINST M6000.1B, Chapter 10.

(19) Package correspondence files and station administrative records for retention IAW Paperwork Management Manual and send to FESEC for final disposition.

(20) Send LORAN operational records to FESEC for retention. Package separately according to required storage duration as specified in COMDTINST M16500.1B, 2.4.1, table 2-4.

(21) Inventory and ship all Radiac equipment with a DD-1149 document to FESEC. Coordinate with FESEC(ecv) to ensure accuracy of current allowance list. Provide copies of DD-1149 documents for any Radiac equipment listed on the allowance list previously turned in. FESEC will consolidate turn in of Radiac equipment account closure for all FESEC units.

(22) Remove all U. S. Coast Guard signs at the site. Ensure unit entrance signs removed, destroyed, and disposed of properly.

(23) Report completion date via message:

(a) Amount of AFC-30 unit OPTAR funds released.

(b) Status and disposition of all accounts: Commissary, Accountable forms, CMS, Morale funds, NMPS movies, operational records, ESO/Dantes account, Post Office account, exchange account and correspondence files.

(c) Gallons and dollar amounts of fuel remaining.

(d) List of personnel not in receipt of PCS orders.

4. Administration, Communications, and Logistics:

a. Administration:

(1) CCGD14(af) will submit form CG-4183, Change of Mailing, Freight and Billing Address allowing as much lead time

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(1) (contd) as possible, but at least 30 days in advance, before disestablishment of LORSTA Marcus Island. CCGD14(af) will submit a second CG-4183 to CG Supply Center Baltimore for the Navy "N" service Unit Identification Code (UIC) for LORSTA Marcus Island.

(2) IRT paragraph 8.a. of reference (a), CCGD14(af) will contact Systems Development (SD) and General Accounting (OG) branches at FINCEN to close out Marcus Island's accounting records and will provide FINCEN with a list of program elements to be cancelled.

(3) FESEC will initiate correspondence to terminate Airlift Mobility Command (AMC) frequency channel requirement.

(4) FESEC will store all NWPAC LORAN C operational records and dispose of them IAW current guidelines.

(5) LORSTA Marcus Island will notify local vendor, in writing, to close out fuel account. Ensure JMSA Prospective Commanding Officer LORSTA Marcus Island has coordinated similar efforts to continue service under JMSA billing. Funding and MIPR support for fuel will be terminated by FESEC and CCGD14(af).

b. Communications

(1) The existing communication systems and network will remain in place for use by JMSA. FESEC will provide liaison to USFJ as needed to ensure DOD-support systems continue in operation IAW reference (d).

(2) CCGD14(dttm) will submit necessary correspondence to delete call sign "NRV6" from applicable publications and delete frequency plan P14.01 from reference (c). Annex Kilo to the D14 SOP should be revised to delete all references to LORSTA Marcus Island. Correspondence will emphasize that listed frequencies are under the control of the U. S. Forces Japan frequency coordinator and will be retained by USFJ for further use by JMSA in accordance with reference (d).

(3) CCGD14(dttm) will take necessary action to cancel general message distribution to FESEC and FESEC units and discontinue AIG EIGHT NINE SIX ZERO effective 15 October 1993.

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(4) COCO NWPAC Chain will transmit AIG message 30 days in advance and at the time of occurrence, announcing the date time group for JMSA assumption of 9970 WHISKEY LORAN-C operations to LORAN-C users.

c. Logistics: Logistics to/from Marcus Island will be provided by USAF AMC aircraft. JMSA personnel will be transported via GOJ aircraft. Station vehicles will be transferred and re-registered to JMSA when no longer needed by USCG.

d. Liaison with JMSA: CO, LORSTA Marcus Island is authorized direct liaison with the senior JMSA officer present during the training period. COMFESEC will provide liaison with the appropriate regional JMSA HQ.

5. Coordinating Instructions:

a. This OPOORDER is effective upon receipt for planning purposes and for execution according to the timetable established by the planning proposal.

b. CCGD14(oan) is the overall coordinator and point of contact for this OPOORDER. Commander, Far East Section is the designated project officer for all NWPAC LORAN station turnover activities. Therefore, COMFESEC will provide all direction and coordination of activities affecting this OPOORDER.

c. Direct liaison is authorized.
