Subj: Accommodations for Corps of Engineers personnel

Ref: (a) Your ltr dtd 15 Jan 1960, file NPAVG-SP

1. Reference (a) stated the Corps of Engineers' need for messing and berthing facilities for government inspectors at Annette Island and Ocean Cape during construction of rearward communications stations at Smugglers Cove (Annette Island) and Yakutat (Ocean Cape) during the period March through November 1960.
2. Accommodations will be available at the Coast Guard Air Detachment, Annette Island for a maximum of four personnel and at the Coast Guard Loran Station, Ocean Cape for a maximum of six personnel during the period requested. Payment for subsistence at the prevailing per diem rate, which is presently two dollars and twenty-six cents, plus a nominal weekly linen fee shall be made by the individuals to the commanding officer of the appropriate unit.
3. Due to operational requirements, Coast Guard vehicles assigned to these stations cannot be committed to provide local transportation for the Corps of Engineers personnel and it is, therefore, suggested that other means of transportation be provided.
4. By copy hereof, Commanding Officers, CG Air Detachment Annette Island and CG Loran Station Ocean Cape are authorized to provide messing and berthing facilities as indicated herein.
