1. This unit presently has attached one (1) officer, fifteen (15) enlisted, and two (2) civilian personnel. In addition, there are two wives, three (3) youngsters under two years old, and one child age seven who are dependent upon this command for proper medical care and administrative services. Since this station has been removed from the Commandant's restricted station list, it is very possible that in the near future we will have more dependents.

How

2. The addition of dependents to our responsibility has increased the work load of administrative personnel, i.e. the commanding officer, the chief electronics technician (also the X.O.), and the corpsman (also the office manager). I am particularly concerned about the responsibilities and duties of the corpsman.

The real problem

3. I feel that the corpsman should have more time to devote to his medical duties. We are presently experiencing bottlenecks in the personnel-supply-medical department.

4. To remedy this situation, I am hereby requesting that reference (a) be amended to include one (1) storekeeper second class who would assume the duties of office manager and supply clerk.
