Please consider this letter as a formal application for permission for the Forest Service to issue a permit for an Air Force installation at Ocean Cape, Alaska, on land partially or wholly occupied by you.

A memorandum of understanding dated June 12, 1956 provides for issuance of such permits by the Forest Service on areas withdrawn for lighthouse reserves where no conflict of use exists.

Commander Fisher and Mr. Morgan of your local office were contacted regarding this proposed permit. Mr. Morgan concurred in its issuance. The permittee will be informed that a lighthouse exists just south of Ocean Cape, and that any construction should not interfere with this aid to navigation.
